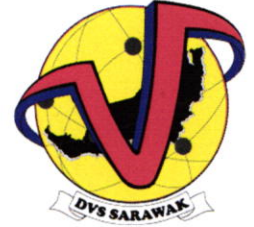

IMPORTATION AND EXPORTATION OF ANIMAL FEED PRODUCTS INTO SARAWAK

The above matter is referred.

2. The Veterinary Public Health Ordinance 1999 Section 9 and Section 48 required any importation or exportation of animal feeds, feed additives, feed concentrate and other substance intended to be added into animal feed into state of Sarawak will required import permit from Department of Veterinary Service Sarawak.

3. All item **must be spelled** out in the permit application instead of generic name (e.g. pet food, chicken feed, fish food). In order to spell out the items, all item to be import or export need to be listed in the dagangnet.com system by submitting application together with product specification (information on the ingredients and origin source), heat treatment flowchart and registration certificate with Feed Board (Feed Act 2009) if any. This is to ensure the proper sanitary phytosanitary risk analysis is properly executed before allowing such product to be imported. Application to list the item can be done by sending email together with attachment to dvs@sarawak.gov.my. Normal application with complete documentation will takes 2-4 working days. If your products list has more than 10 items, please kindly list them in excel format.

4. Please be reminded that a fine not exceeding fifty thousand ringgit or imprisonment not exceeding two years or both such fine and imprisonment and a fine not exceeding fifteen thousand ringgit or imprisonment not exceeding one year or both such fine and imprisonment if convicted guilty of Section 9 and Section 48 respectively of the Veterinary Public Health Ordinance 1999
