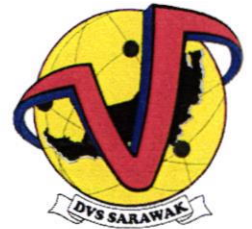

**EMPOWERED UNDER SECTION 9 (1) / 48 (3) OF
THE VETERINARY PUBLIC HEALTH ORDINANCE 1999**

**REGULATIONS FOR THE IMPORTATION OF ANIMAL FEED and etc. INTO SARAWAK
(Effective 20 May 2021)**

- A. Product** : **Animal Feed, Pet Food, Fish and Shrimp Feed (including feed additives such as vitamins, minerals), In-feed antibiotics**
- B. Place of export** : **West Malaysia, Sabah and any country**
- C. Purpose** : **For feeding of animal (including pets), fish and shrimp and animal feed manufacturing**

D. Regulations for the importation: -

1) Import Permit

Each consignment of cooked and heat-processed animal, fish and shrimp feed and feed additives and in-feed antibiotics shall be accompanied by a valid import permit issued by the State Veterinary Authority, Department of Veterinary Services Sarawak permitting entry into Sarawak, Malaysia.

2) Veterinary Certification

a) For import from overseas and Sabah

Each consignment of **animal, pet food, fish and shrimp feed (including feed additives such as vitamins, minerals)**, shall be accompanied by a **Veterinary Health Certificate or Veterinary Certificate** written in English dated within 14 days of export and signed or endorsed by the competent veterinary authority of the country of origin giving details of the consignment (such as name and address of consignor, consignee and manufacturing facility and quantity, type and origin of raw material and products) and certifying that:

- i. the animal, fish and shrimp feed has been manufactured entirely in the exporting country and in a manufacturing facility approved and monitored by the Competent Veterinary Authority of the exporting country/state.
- ii. the animal, fish and shrimp feed contain animal protein derived from fish, poultry, cattle, goats, sheep, deer, swine and buffalo which are healthy and not from diseased animal, or which died from contamination or disease outbreak.
- iii. the country/state of export is free from Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy (BSE) and Transmissible Spongiform Encephalopathy (TSE)/prion, Scrapie or in the case that the country is not free from BSE, TSE and Scrapie, no cattle, buffalo deer, sheep and goat have been used to manufacture the pet food.
- iv. there has been no outbreak of African Swine Fever, Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD) and Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) **within 10 km radius of the manufacturing facility.**
- v. pelletized / crumbled animal, fish and shrimp feed referred in the certificate has been manufactured according to standard processing technique and has been subjected to heat treatment to reach an internal core temperature of at least 70 degrees centigrade for a period of not less than 30 minutes or to any equivalent treatment which has been demonstrated to kill virus and bacteria.
- vi. All necessary precaution has been taken to prevent contamination of the animal feed referred in the certificate from pathogens.
- vii. the product from African Swine Fever infected countries/states **must not contain pork or pork product.**

b) For import from West Malaysia

- i. Animal, pet food, fish and shrimp feed (including feed additives such as vitamins, minerals) **manufactured** in West Malaysia must comply to Feed (Manufacture and Sale of Feed or Feed Additive) Regulations 2012.
