POULTRY PART IMPORTATION INTO SARAWAK

The above matter and letter with ref number (2) DVS/HQ/700-4/1/7 VOL. 2 dated 31 Mar 2020 are referred.

1. The Veterinary Public Health Ordinance 1999 empowered State Veterinary Authority to made following order made in lieu of the current market needs for your further action.

- a. As the ban is still in force via letter referenced number (2) DVS/HQ/700-4/1/7 VOL. 2 dated 31 Mar 2020, any importation must precede by importer writing in to seek approval from Director of Veterinary Service Sarawak stating
 - i. Type of poultry part to import;
 - ii. Quantity of poultry part to import;
 - iii. Which plant and/or country the poultry part intended to import from;
 - iv. Attach approval letter/email as supporting document for import permit application via ePermit system
 - v. Permit fee is RM0.10/kg as stated in Third Schedule of The Veterinary Public Health Ordinance 1999
- b. Approved plants for importation into Sarawak are as below
 - i. DANISH FINEST CHICKEN (DAFC A/S) (DK5959)
 - ii. PLUIMVEEVERWERKING GEBO. HEIJS (NL5048EG)
 - iii. SAHA FARMS CO., LTD THAILAND (EST. NO 44)
 - iv. All approved plant in Malaysia with VHM certification

You are required to check on [exporting country disease status](#) before apply for approval.

- c. All poultry parts importation must comply to the Import Conditions for Poultry part
 - i. [Within Malaysia](#)
 - ii. [Outside Malaysia](#)

2. Department of Veterinary Services Sarawak would like to remind importers to import from approve plant by DVS Malaysia to ensure the quality, safety, hygiene and the Halal status of the product.
