

WHAT IS THE STRATEGIC TRADE ACT 2010 (STA 2010)?

The Strategic Trade Act is a legislation that controls the export, transshipment, transit and brokering of strategic items, as well as activities related to the design, development, production and delivery of weapons of mass destruction.

This Act is in line with the United Nations Security Council's Resolution to establish an export control system for the purpose of non-proliferation of weapons of mass destruction. In other words, the STA 2010 helps to facilitate trade in a secure, legal and weapon-free trading environment.

OBJECTIVES:

- To provide control on activities for export, transit, transshipment, brokering and other related activities
- To protect Malaysian exporters from being used as a channel for supplying illegal strategic goods
- To secure a weapon-free trade environment

ARE MY TRADING ACTIVITIES AFFECTED BY THE STA 2010?

If you are involved in export/transit/transshipment/brokering of strategic items (as per described in STA Product List), you are required to obtain an export permit / broker certificate from the relevant authorities based on the Strategic Trade Act 2010.

How to start using ePermit STA:


PRE-REGISTRATION

Registration for company, applicants, and users & strategic items. Subject to approval by MITI and other relevant agencies.


PERMIT APPLICATION
