



## **NOTICE ON APPLICATION PROCEDURE FOR CERTIFICATE OF ENERGY EFFICIENCY (COE) IN COMPLIANCE WITH ENERGY EFFICIENCY & CONSERVATION ACT (EECA)**

Energy Efficiency & Conservation Act comes into effect on 1st January 2025. Under this Act, for the energy using product intended to be sold in Malaysia market is required to fulfill the following requirement:

- Manufacturers and importers shall obtain a Certificate of Efficiency (COE) to distribute energy-using products in Malaysia.
- Manufacturer and importers who intends to distribute energy using product shall be registered and obtained a Certificate of Registration (COR)

Starting from 1<sup>st</sup> Mac 2025, we have developed a procedure for COE application. Manufacturers and importers may apply for COE by adhering to the steps outlined below:

### **Step 1 : Understanding Energy-Using Products**

Determine if your product falls under the category of an Energy-Using Product (EUP). Refer to the Guideline for Energy-Using Products to confirm whether your product is classified as an EUP.

### **Step 2 : Submit a COE Application via COA Application (Certificate of Approval):**

No separate application required for COE, applicants may apply for a COE by applying for Certificate of Approval (COA) through the ePermit system. Applicants shall follow the procedures detailed in the Guideline for the Approval of Electrical Equipment 2024 and submit the document as listed in the Guideline for the Approval of Electrical Equipment 2024. (From Page 43 onwards).

### **Step 3 : Evaluation**

After the application is submitted, it will undergo an evaluation process. Once the evaluation is successfully completed, it will proceed to the payment stage.

#### **Step 4 : Payment Notification and Details:**

Upon successful evaluation of the application, the applicant will receive an email requesting payment of RM 250.00 for the COE. The payment breakdown is as follows:

- RM 30.00: Application fee for the Certificate of Energy Efficiency
- RM 220.00: Issuance fee for the Certificate of Energy Efficiency

#### **Step 5 : Payment Process:**

A payment link will be provide in an email that will be sent to the applicants. Applicants must complete the required information in the Payment Gateway to ensure accurate processing and receipt issuance. The following details are required:

- Application ID: SJT xxxxxx (refer to the ePermit system for this number)
- Model No.: Must match the model number submitted in the COA application
- ROC Number
- Company Name
- Company Address
- Applicant Email Address

#### **Step 6 : COE Issuance:**

Once payment is verified, the applicant will receive an email containing the COE, MEPS Label in Adobe Illustrator(AI) format and payment receipt.

#### **Important Notes:**

- If you have a COA that is still valid after 1 Jan 2025, you may apply for transition to COE using this [link](#) .
- The COE will only be issued for energy-using products that have passed the energy efficiency evaluation.
- For safety compliance, applicants must follow the steps outlined in the Guideline for the Approval of Electrical Equipment 2024 to obtain the COA.
- Starting from 4<sup>th</sup> March 2025, those who fail to obtain the COE will not be permitted to import or manufacture energy-using products in Malaysia. Any such product imported or manufactured on or after this date and found in the market will be subject to legal action.
